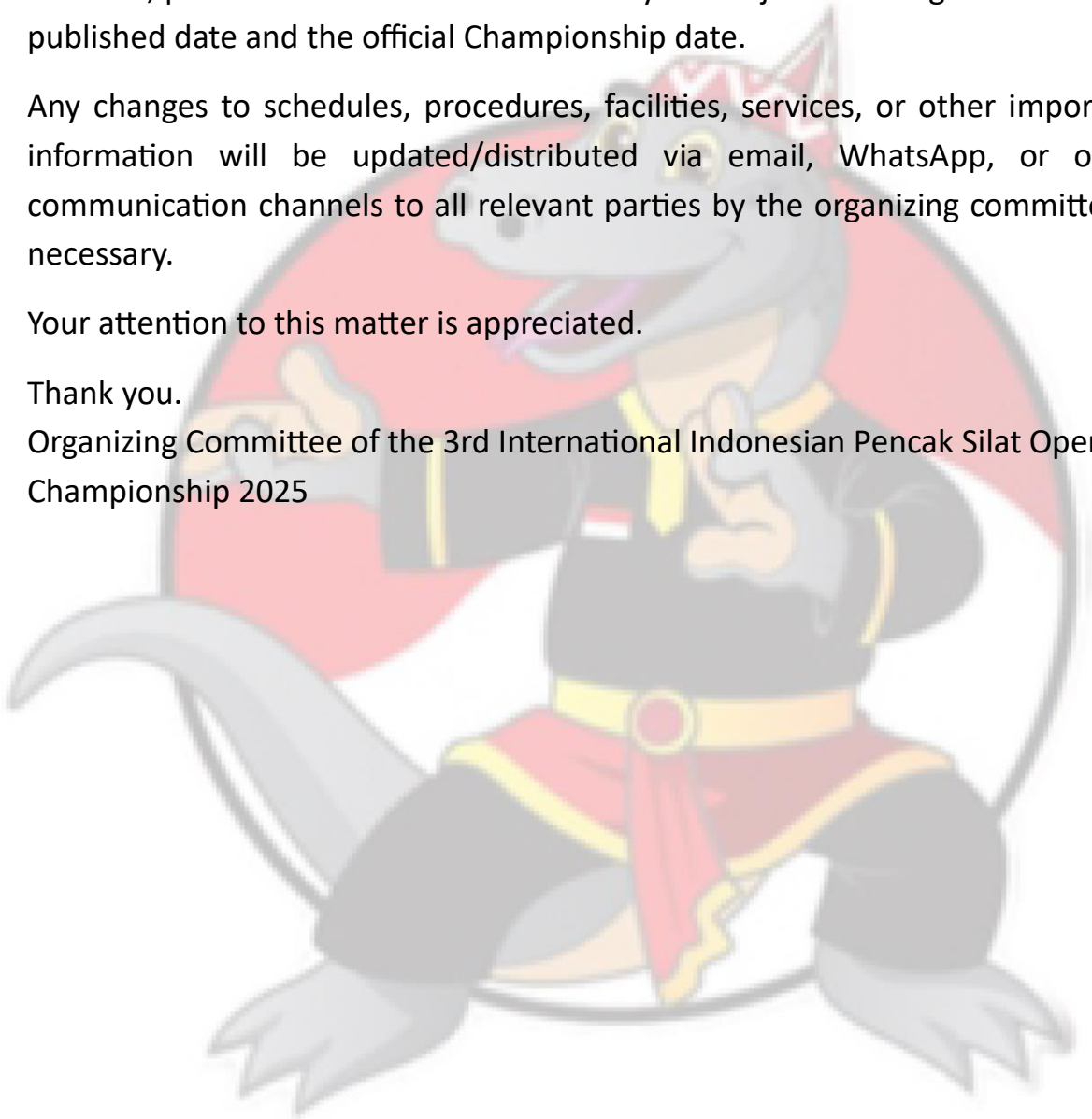

## I. INTRODUCTION / BACKGROUND

Pencak Silat is a martial art originating from the cultural roots of the Malay world, whose existence must be preserved to enable future generations to learn it. Beyond maintaining its existence, the aim of teaching Pencak Silat to the younger generation is rooted in its positive values. These values, when properly applied, can shape a strong and admirable personal character.

In addition to embodying philosophical values aligned with Pancasila, such as ethical, technical, aesthetic, and athletic values useful for life, Pencak Silat encompasses five aspects: social interaction, sportsmanship, self-defense, artistry, and mental-spiritual development.

Nowadays, Pencak Silat competitions at Regional and National levels are held with increasing frequency across various age groups, ranging from early childhood, pre-teens, teenagers, students, university students, and adults. International Pencak Silat tournaments are also becoming more common, featured in multi-sport events like the SEA Games, ASEAN University Games, and Asian Games 2018, as well as single events like the Belgium Open and World Championship.

The growing number of National and International Pencak Silat tournaments highlights its rising popularity among communities globally. Ultimately, it is hoped that Pencak Silat will eventually be included in Olympic events.

To support the efforts of Pencak Silat's journey towards the Olympics, the Government has designated Pencak Silat as one of the priority sports for development, as reflected in the National Sports Grand Design outlined in Presidential Regulation No. 86 of 2021.

To continue recruiting new Pencak Silat athletes, one of the programs of the National Board of the Indonesian Pencak Silat Association (PB IPSI) is organizing an international single-event Pencak Silat tournament titled: **"3rd International Indonesian Pencak Silat Open Championship 2025."**

May this event proceed successfully.

## IX. TERMS AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMPETITION

The rules and regulations of the competition are prepared in accordance with those established by the International Pencak Silat Federation (PERSILAT) and the International Pencak Silat Competition Rules as of October 9, 2023 (Version 7). Specifically, there will be no locking techniques in the youth category..

### Participant Requirements

1. Must be selected Pencak Silat members representing a country, provincial organization, city organization, institution, school, or club.
2. Each contingent is required to bring their own competition equipment and body protector that complies with IPSI regulations for 2023.
3. Athletes who withdraw or are unable to attend will automatically be disqualified.
4. If a contingent is dissatisfied with the match result, they may protest to the match supervisor by completing a form accompanied by an administration fee of 300 USD (Three Hundred US Dollars), submitted no later than 10 minutes after the winner's decision. Protests submitted without following the prescribed procedure will be considered invalid and regarded as a violation of the rules. If still dissatisfied, an appeal may be filed with an administration fee of 200 USD (Two Hundred US Dollars). The protest fee is non-refundable.



5. Domestic athletes who participate will receive BPJS Ketenagakerjaan insurance provided their data is accurate and valid.
6. Foreign participants will be provided with first aid in the event of an accident during the competition.
7. All participants, including athletes and officials, must agree not to cause disturbances during the competition that could harm any parties.
8. All participants registering for this championship are deemed to have agreed to all regulations and policies set by the committee.
9. If any officials or athletes violate the regulations and policies, the committee reserves the right to remove the contingent or athlete from the championship.

#### A. Match Category

1. The Performance Category participants must wear standard IPSI uniforms
2. The FULL PERFORMANCE system will be used.
3. Weigh-ins will be conducted once per day of the competition.
4. Weigh-ins will take place from 06:00 to 10:00 Western Indonesia Time (WIB).
5. All participants MUST prepare and submit the original "Health Certificate" issued by at least a Class D Hospital on the Re-registration day.
6. All weigh-ins will be carried out on the morning of the competition day, prior to the first match (with no weight tolerance).
7. For injury treatment at the hospital, injured athletes are given until 13:00 to weigh in on the following day after the tournament.
8. When reporting for weigh-ins, athletes must wear the standard Pencak Silat uniform without a belt, groin protector, or other protective gear.
9. Athletes will be given the option to completely remove clothing before proceeding with the weigh-in.
10. Towels/fabric will be provided to assist athletes.
11. Separate rooms will be arranged for weigh-ins. No tolerances will be allowed.



12. If an athlete decides to remove clothing after standing on the scale and realizes they do not meet the required weight, they will be disqualified
13. An "ID CARD" must be worn during the registration and weigh-in process.

#### B. Artistic Category

1. Attire must comply with the standard IPSI uniform for the art category.
2. The FULL PERFORMANCE system will be applied.
3. Long knives (golok or parang) must adhere to PERSILAT regulations, made of metal, and blunted (without sharp edges).
4. Staff/Long Stick/Tembung must be made from natural rattan and conform to PERSILAT size regulations.
5. Props for the Jurus category MUST be inspected by the committee accompanied by referees and judges before the competition begins.

#### C. Scoring System

The organizers will use the "Digital Scoring System" for every match and "Video Assistant Referee."

#### D. Protocols, Etiquette, and Dress Discipline During the Event:

1. Opening/Closing Ceremony attire must be the official team uniform or standard Pencak Silat attire.
2. During Prize Distribution, athletes must wear the official team uniform or standard Pencak Silat attire.
3. During the competition, coaches and athletes must wear standard Pencak Silat attire in the competition area, including when entering the inspection room, during matches, or accompanying athletes. The attire must include belts and an ID Card.

#### E. Protocols, Etiquette, and Time Discipline During the Event:

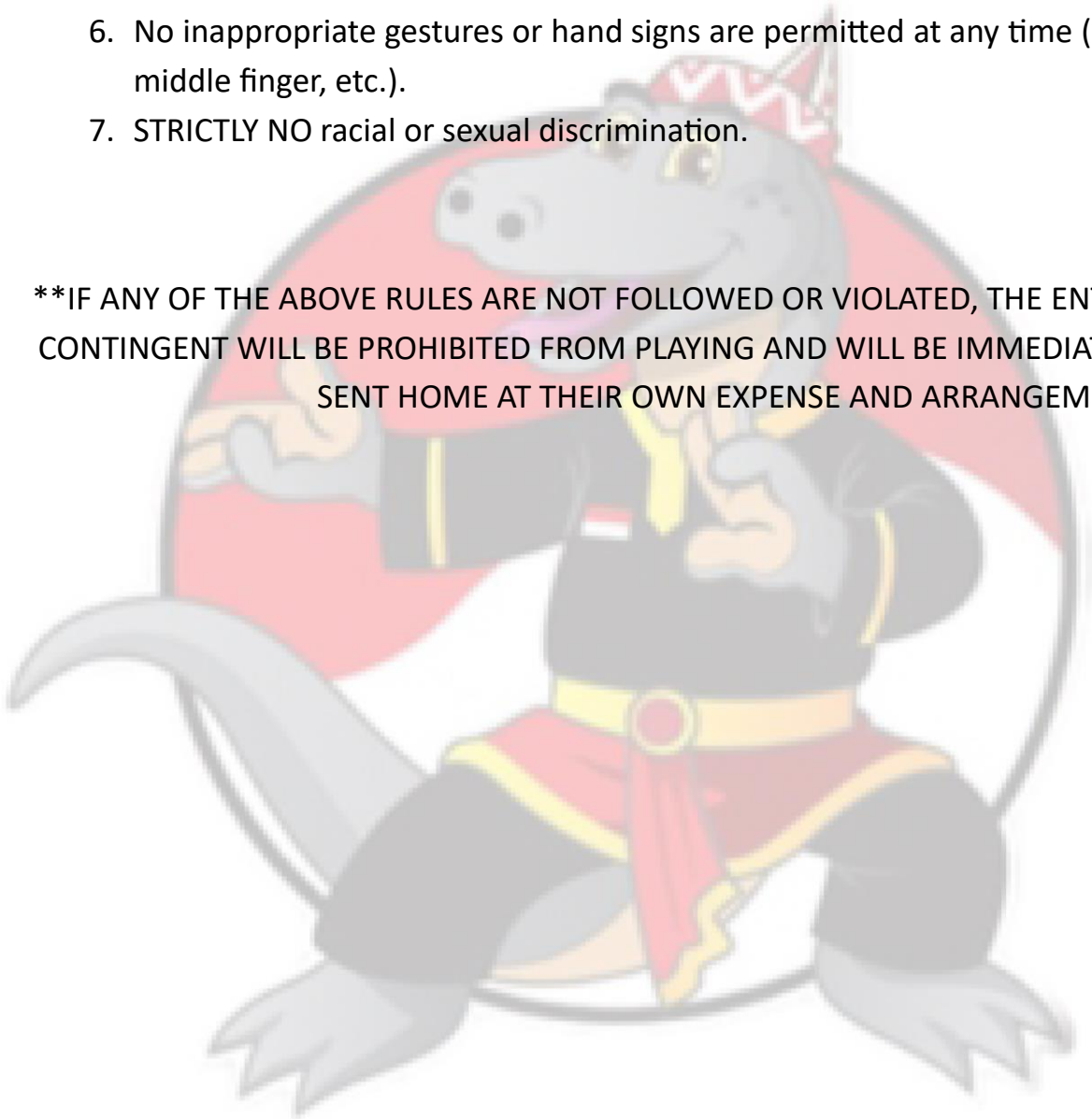
1. All participants must be punctual and present at every ceremony and event according to the official schedule.
2. Participants must always maintain a good personal appearance, demonstrate good behavior, and embody a spirit of sportsmanship.





3. Participants must attend and adhere to every ceremony in an orderly manner and must not cause any disruption or actions that could disturb the ceremony's decorum.
4. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against athletes who violate rules or exhibit poor behavior.
5. No use of abusive language or words is allowed at any time.
6. No inappropriate gestures or hand signs are permitted at any time (e.g., middle finger, etc.).
7. STRICTLY NO racial or sexual discrimination.

**\*\*IF ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES ARE NOT FOLLOWED OR VIOLATED, THE ENTIRE CONTINGENT WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM PLAYING AND WILL BE IMMEDIATELY SENT HOME AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE AND ARRANGEMENT.**





## X. INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPANTS

1. Each registered participant from abroad must possess a passport from their home country.
2. Every participant will be issued an official access card by the organizer as proof of valid qualification.
3. All participants must have a health certificate issued by a hospital with a minimum classification of D in their respective regions.

## XI. COMPETITION PRIZES: MEDALS, TROPHIES & MASCOTS

1. Match Category
  - a) 1st Place - Gold Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each class.
  - b) 2nd Place - Silver Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each class.
  - c) Joint 3rd Place - Bronze Medal and Certificate for 2 people in each class.
2. Artistic Category
  - a) 1st Place - Gold Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each class
  - b) 2nd Place - Silver Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each class
  - c) Joint 3rd Place - Bronze Medal and Certificate for 2 people in each class.



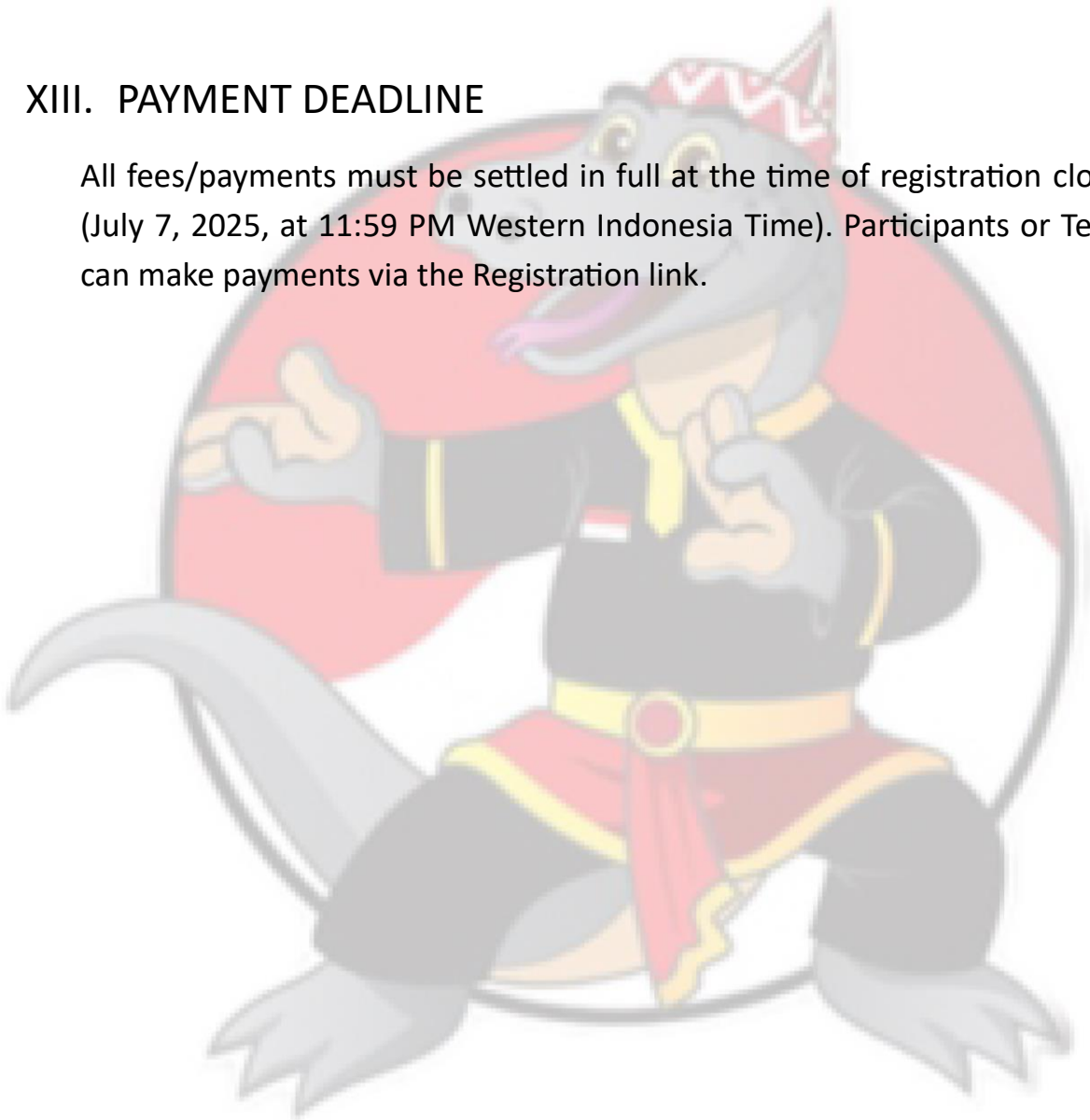

#### XIV. BEST ATHLETE AWARDS AND OVERALL CHAMPIONS

1. Best male and female athletes in the competition category will receive a Champion Trophy, Certificate, and Development Fund.
2. Best male and female athletes in the artistic category will receive a Champion Trophy, Certificate, and Development Fund.
3. The best athletes are selected based on the following criteria:
  - Performance and points in each match
  - Sportsmanship and good presentation
  - The number of matches (Rounds) the athlete must go through

##### Juara Umum

There will be a total of 2 categories (Youth and Adult) that can be won throughout the competition as detailed below. The trophies will be awarded based on the number of "Gold Medals" achieved, followed by "Silver & Bronze Medals" and the number of participants, in case of a tie in Gold or Silver Medal recipients.

- A. Overall Champion 1 - Trophy, Certificate, and Development Fund
- B. Overall Champion 2 - Trophy, Certificate, and Development Fund
- C. Overall Champion 3 - Trophy, Certificate, and Development Fund

#### XV. FORCE MAJEURE

Force Majeure refers to circumstances beyond control caused by unrest, natural disasters, government policies regarding the state of the country, and other events outside human capability that directly affect the event or its progress. If force majeure occurs, contingents cannot withdraw from participation; however, the event will be rescheduled and resumed once conditions are safe and normal.

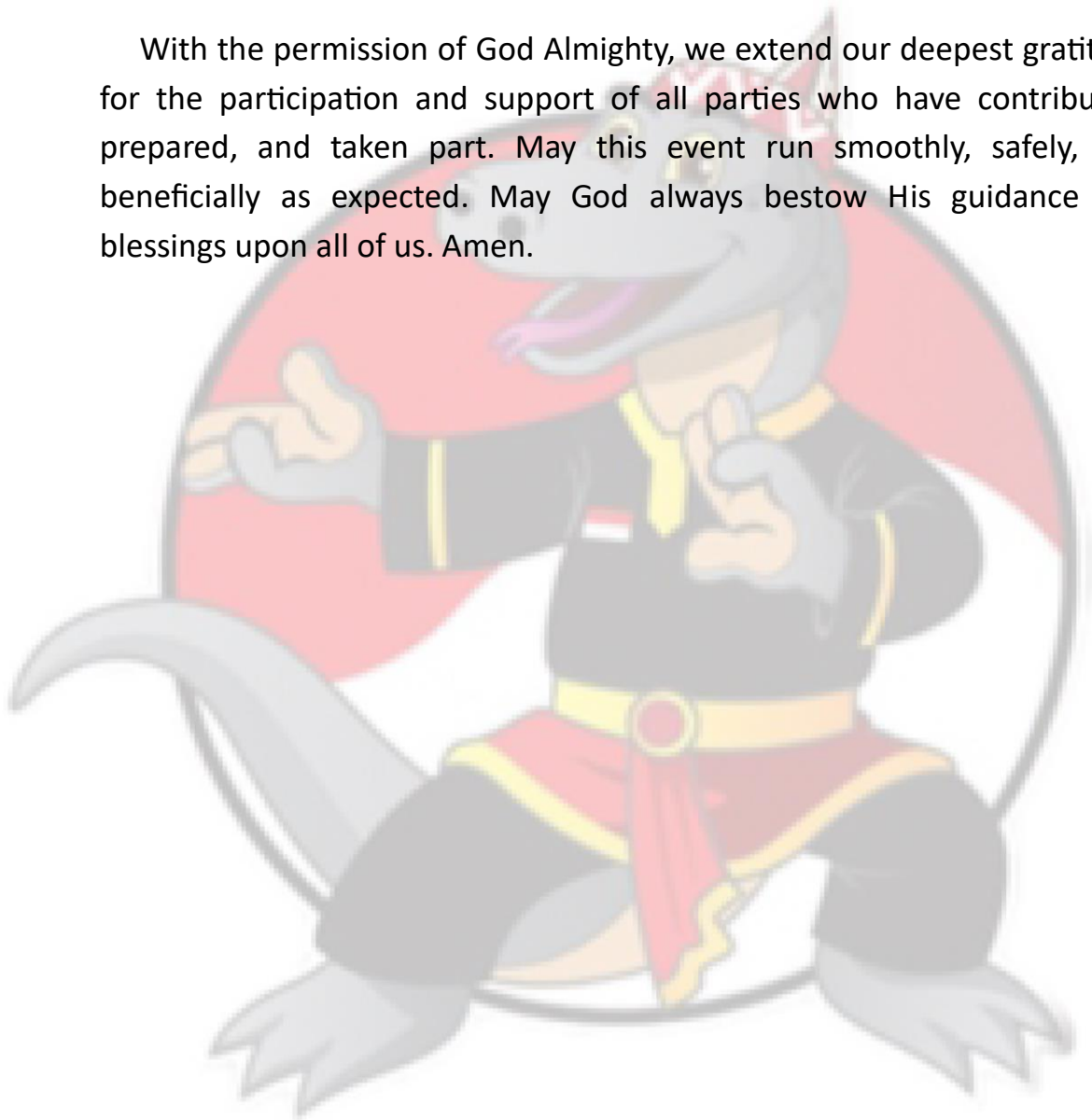
